



The following information is required prior to the application deadline.

Application

- A copy of your current resume and cover letter
- The email address and phone number of two work-related or professional references

Education

- A copy of your PCP diploma from an accredited institution

Vehicle Safety

- A copy of your recent driver's abstract issued within the last 30 days (obtained from local Motor Vehicle Branch or Service New Brunswick)
- Photocopy of front and back of valid Class 4 driver's license (or equivalent) with minimum one year driving experience
- Copy of any valid Driver's course certificate i.e. CEVO, VFIS or NS VSP or equivalent issued within the last three years

Professional Requirements

- Proof of registration with Paramedic Association of New Brunswick (if you are not currently registered in New Brunswick, please visit PANB at www.panb.ca)
- Proof of completion of a Physical Abilities Test (PAT) specific to working as a paramedic within the last 12 months
- Proof of valid CPR certification issued in the last 12 months

Immunization Record

- Tetanus (Dtap) within the last 5 years
- 2 MMR vaccines (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) or lab evidenced immunity
- 2 Varicella vaccines (Chicken Pox) or lab evidenced immunity
- 3 Hepatitis B doses and/or Lab evidenced immunity
- TB Skin Test (2 step); if reactive a follow up chest xray

Proof of full vaccination against COVID-19, or a valid medical certificate exempting you from the vaccine. Unvaccinated employees will be required to follow all workplace mitigation measures determined by the Employer, based on Public Health guidance.

Please note, a meeting with our Employee Health and Wellness Consultant can be scheduled, to ensure that all vaccinations are up to date by the time an offer is made.

Entitled to Work in Canada

- Reason for which you are entitled to work in Canada (Canadian citizenship, permanent resident status or work permit)

Criminal Record

- A copy of your criminal record check issued within the last 30 days (including a vulnerable sector check)

Language Assessment

- Valid Official Language Assessments in both French and English from the Department of Post-secondary Education, Training and Labour. You can contact them at LS-SL@gnb.ca. Please take into account the additional time to receive your language assessment.

Note: Failure to provide any of the above requested information may prevent you from proceeding further in the selection process with Ambulance New Brunswick.
